

## A.C. Frieden Returns to Acapulco with Newly Publishing Novel

**ACAPULCO, Mexico (June 16, 2006)** – Mystery novelist A.C. Frieden returned to Acapulco, Mexico, and to the Las Brisas resort, the spectacular setting for key scenes in his debut novel, *Canvas Sunsets Never Fade*. Using the resort as his base of operations, Richard Nash, the story's main character, tracks down the elusive Lina Mundhir, a wealthy entrepreneur and sister of the FBI's lead suspect wanted in connection with the murder of the Saudi Ambassador's wife. But Nash's success in finding Lina is short-lived, as both suddenly find themselves pursued by killers who will stop at nothing to silence them. They barely escape from Acapulco and head inland in a desperate attempt to stay alive.

This was Frieden's fifth stay at Acapulco's Las Brisas resort, but his first since *Canvas Sunsets Never Fade* was published in 2004. He had the pleasure of again meeting several members of the resort's management and donating copies of his book.
